Veterans can meet with a VA provider by video in a private room at local VSO locations. This new option can benefit Veterans with long travel times to VA health care facilities or limited connectivity at home.



## Video Telehealth Services at VSOs



Using VA Video Connect, Veterans can connect with a VA provider through **secure**, **real-time video**.




VSO locations provide Veterans with a **private appointment room** to virtually meet with a VA provider.



Internet/Wi-Fi and telephone capabilities are available within appointment rooms.



An **on-site attendant** is available at ATLAS sites to assist Veterans with using telehealth equipment.



## VA Clinical Services at VSOs

ATLAS (Accessing Telehealth through Local Area Stations) sites **offer health care services that don't require hands-on exams**. These services may include, but are not limited to, primary care, mental health counseling, clinical pharmacy services, nutrition services, and social work.
